Day 1 Monday August 26 2023 Brisbane > Sunshine Coast > Fraser Island LD

The humpbacks' natural curiosity takes over. They glide up to the boats and in return, put on an almighty show - slapping their tails, waving their pec fins and breaching into the air, for a truly larger-than-life spectacle.

The team aboard Quick Cat II will provide an unforgettable day out on the World Heritage-listed waters, joining in on the excitement as you witness these **oceanic giants up close**.

We then return for a hearty lunch back at the Resort

Time now for a rest beside the pool or choose to go for a stroll before we are joined by one of the rangers for a Bush Tucker talk and taste – then a special dinner in the Seabelle Restaurant
